## **RESOLUTION No. 2022-058**

BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING ENFORCEMENT SECURITY AND INVESTIGATION AGENCY, INC. WITH THE LOWEST CALCULATED BID AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER AND RECOMMENDING AWARD FOR THE PROCUREMENT PROJECT: PROCUREMENT OF TWELVE (12) MONTH-SECURITY SERVICES FOR CY 2023, BID REFERENCE NO. UPB-BID2022-EPA2023-04

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created to ensure transparency in the procurement process and in the implementation of procurement contracts, with the end view of guaranteeing that contracts are awarded pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and that all procurement are conducted strictly according to specifications;

WHEREAS, the University of the Philippines Baguio continuously advertised the Invitation to Bid for the Procurement Project: PROCUREMENT OF TWELVE (12) MONTH-SECURITY SERVICES FOR CY 2023, Bid Reference Number UPB-BID2022-EPA2023-04, with an Approved Budget Contract (ABC) in the amount of Eight Million Three Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Eight Pesos and Fifty One Centavos (Php 8,398,158.51), at the University of the Philippines Baguio website, the Philippines BAC Bulletin Board and in conspicuous places at the premises of the University of the Philippines Baguio from 11 October to 18 October 2022;

WHEREAS, on 19 October 2022 at 10:30 AM, the BAC conducted a Pre-Bid Conference for the procurement project at the Board Room to discuss, clarify and explain, among other things, the eligibility requirements, and the technical and financial components of the contract to be bid in which six (6) prospective suppliers namely: (1) Kidron Security Investigation Agency (2) Northcom Security and Investigation Agency (3) Carlo Maximus Security Agency Inc. (4) Enforcement Security and Investigation Agency (5) Grand Meritus Security Agency (6) ITAWES Security Proactive Agency attended the conference;

WHEREAS, on 27 October 2022, pursuant to the said Pre-Bid Conference, the BAC issued one (1) Supplemental/Bid Bulletin announcing clarifications and amendments to the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, six (6) bidders purchased bid documents namely: (1) Northcom Security & Investigation Agency, Inc., (2) Carlo Maximus Security Agency, Inc., (3) Enforcement Security and Investigation Agency, Inc. (4) Kidron Security Investigation Agency, (5) Oakwood Security & Investigation Agency, Inc. and (6) Glocke Security Systems, Inc.;

WHEREAS, on 3 November 2022, the scheduled submission and opening of bids, six (6) suppliers, submitted their bids;

WHEREAS, after opening the technical and financial component envelopes, the BAC declared five (5) bidders eligible & one (1) bidder ineligible and their bid amounts are as follows:

WHEREAS, on 20 December 2022, the Technical Working Group (TWG) presented to the BAC and Observers, the result of the post-qualification and reported that Enforcement Security and Investigation Agency, Inc. has complied with the technical specifications of the project and is responsive to all legal and technical documents for eligibility, marked as Annex "A";

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group (TWG) presented the bid evaluation for the financial proposals:
